He is Vice Chair of the T'ai Tsung organisation and is a Senior Coach for the children competition team.

The instructor for the Adults classes is Errol Lynch who has been an instructor of T'ai Tsung for four years. He is also a registered Doctor of Traditional Chinese

including: Kieran Curry, who is currently in the England squad, and the under 75 kg British full contact San Shou (free fighting) champion, and Reuben Roberts was the under 80kg British Champion 2001. As well as being top fighters both of these have gone on to university. Other high achieving local students are Veronika Rogers-Thomas, who is an assistant instructor and qualified primary school teacher and Dominic Simpson, the Assistant Instructor to the Adults class, who is a qualified secondary school teacher and was a former Head Boy at the St Thomas More school.

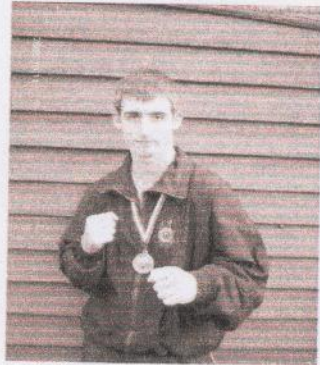
Enfield Kung Fu Stars Sweep Medals
